Genuine Leather Steering Wheel Cover INSTALLATION AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these instructions carefully to ensure a proper tight fit for your Genuine Leather Steering Wheel Cover. Time required: 30 to 60 minutes.

Honda Genuine Leather Steering Wheel Covers are designed to fit tightly on your steering wheel. The lacing cord is unbreakable and the lacing holes are reinforced to resist tearing so you can pull very tightly on the cord while lacing. **You may want to wear gloves to protect your hands during installation.**

1. Stretch and properly position the steering wheel cover on the steering wheel with the sewn seam at the bottom of the wheel. If there are any spaces on the cover without holes, be sure that they line up with the spokes of your steering wheel.

2. Thread the lacing needle as shown.



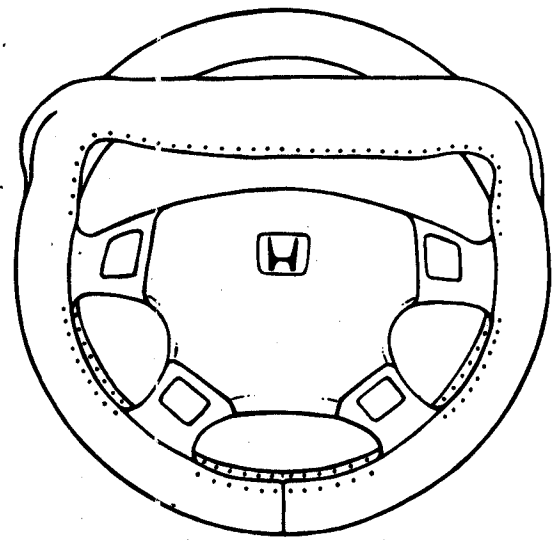
3. Begin lacing at any point on the steering wheel which is NOT at the sewn seam or at a spoke of the wheel.

TO START:

Insert the needle between the edges of the cover and out through a front hole. Pull all but a few inches of the lacing out through the hole. Leave these few inches of lacing to tie at the finish. Then insert the needle through the rear hole directly behind the starting front hole and diagonally through to the next front hole to the left. Pull the stitch tight and continue lacing in this manner. Pull each stitch tight as you lace to lock the edges of the steering wheel together. You cannot tighten more than one stitch at a time. Remember: **TIGHT IS RIGHT!**

4. After you have laced around the wheel, insert the needle through the last rear hole and up between the edges of the cover. The two ends of the lacing cord should now be sticking out between the edges of the cover. Tie a tight double knot and clip off the excess lacing at the knot. Tuck the knot out of the way and under the edges of the cover.

Care for your Genuine Leather Steering Wheel Cover as you would any fine leather article. Use only saddle soap or mild cleaners and conditioners made for soft leathers. Do not use strong all purpose cleaners or chemicals, as they will dry out the leather. Also, the leather in this steering wheel cover has been prepared with special coatings and finishes to ensure long life. Some perfumes, colognes, and aftershave lotions contain alcohol and other chemicals which may harm the finish. You may want to be sure that your hands are free of these substances before driving.

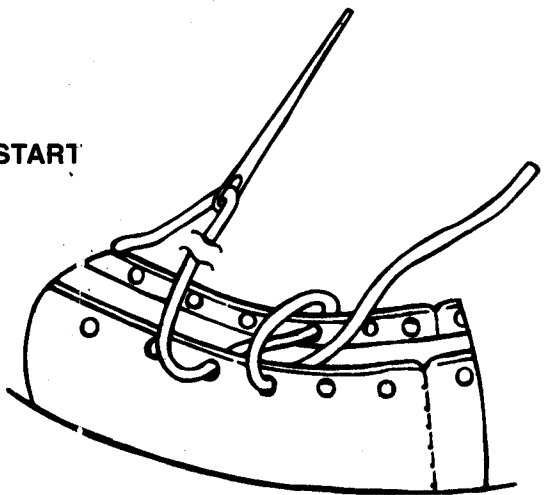


STARTING POINT
